Dear 8<sup>th</sup> & 9<sup>th</sup> grade students and parents,

You will be prompted to set up login credentials. **If you were a camper in 2024/25**, you will login with your login credentials. Then enter your Group Code –**BLCNORTHFIELD** when prompted (this is also on your contract). All continue:

Complete or update your medical and permission forms – items you will need for your medical forms before you get started if you did not attend in 2024/25; guardian and emergency contact information; medications you take, insurance information, a copy of your recent Dr's physical, sports physical or scout physical dated within 24 months of arriving at camp to upload.

When you get to the screen that shows downloadable forms – print out the ones you want before moving on. Also, the upload on this screen is where you will upload your Dr's physical. You can add a Dr's physical later but 2 weeks prior to arriving at camp.

If you need assistance, you can call tech support at 866-433-4548 (they are friendly and very helpful) during normal business hours – Eastern standard time.

Please be sure let me know as well! Bethel likes to have a copy of the forms. The \$150 non-refundable deposit is payable to Bethel Lutheran Church. I will send individualized update after Plant Sale Deliveries and Garage Sale fundraising efforts, and final payment is due June 1.

**If you are still in discernment or want to be inspired, please come to a Christikon Trips Update Meeting on Wednesday, April 29, at 6:30 pm.** One of our seniors, Fletcher Aylin, is going to share how special the backpacking trip was for him.
